

Mo'olelo Presents Good Boys, a story of Reconciliation at work!

Mo'olelo Production company, now in residence at the La Jolla Playhouse presents a story of Victim-Offender reconciliation with it's newest production of Good Boy written by Jane Martin and Directed by Seema Sueko.

Good Boys is the story of two men, one black one white, who meet eight years after a school shooting in which both their sons died, one a victim the other the shooter. As the fathers search for understanding and viciously cast blame, they confront difficult questions about vengeance and responsibility. Like the characters in the play - who are coming to terms with issues of vengeance and responsibility after a crime - RJMP brings together juvenile offenders and victims to discuss the motives and effects of a crime. A trained volunteer mediator oversees the meetings between offender and victim, helps the parties develop a restitution agreement and tracks the case until the restitution is fulfilled.
