For School Personnel

This 20-hour training program will teach a step-by-step classroom discipline process designed to increase cooperation, mutual respect and responsibility among students and teachers. Using restorative justice skills and strategies, the DTR program trains educators and administrators in the DTR process, helping them to create a more positive learning environment while actively reducing suspensions and expulsions, including those due to “willful defiance.” DTR is a Fresno Pacific University (FPU) curriculum developed by Ron and Roxanne Claassen being taught in San Diego by **certified trainers, Heather Lampron and Joe O’Quinn.**
